### Dakota Select Seed

Dakota Select Seed (DSS) is a marketing and distribution seed program for varieties licensed to the North Dakota Crop Improvement and Seed Association. The objectives of this group are to produce, market, and promote seed in the certified seed industry.

### Grower/Member Requirements:

- DSS member eligibility requirements:
  - One time Membership fee of \$100.00
  - Must have a current seed Labeling Permit (ND Member only)
  - History of timely research fee reporting and payment

### Reporting Requirements:

- Growers must complete all forms and submit by deadline
- Reports will consist of:
  - Planting & Production report (acres and bushels planted) due June 15<sup>th</sup> of production season.
  - Planting & Production report (gross bushels from Certified and non-Certified/failed acres) due December 1<sup>st</sup> following production season
  - If applicable sales report (total retail sales and carryover bushels) due September 1<sup>st</sup> the year following the seed sale season
- Failure to meet reporting requirements will result in denial to access seed the next year with reinstatement subject to committee's approval
- All forms should be submitted to the NDCISA office.

### Payment of Fees:

- All research fees will be collected by the North Dakota State Seed Department for North Dakota Growers. These fees are due September 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.

- Payment of checkoff fees will be due September 1<sup>st</sup>.

## **Certification Requirements:**

### Classes of certified seed

#### ➤ **Oat:**

- Souris, Rockford, Newburg (PVP with no Title V) and Jury (Not PVP)
  - Foundation
  - Registered\*
  - Certified
  - Quality Assured

\*Registered class can be planted by the grower/licensee or can be sold to members of DSS to raise certified or QA class seed. Registered seed can be used to supply international licensees if need is recognized and approved by committee.

#### ➤ **Barley:**

- **Rawson Barley** (PVP with Title V)
  - Foundation
  - Registered\*
  - Certified

\*Registered class can be planted by the grower/licensee or can be sold to members of DSS to raise certified seed. Registered seed can be used to supply international licensees if need is recognized and approved by committee.

#### ➤ **Winter Wheat : Overland and Freeman**

- **Overland Winter Wheat** (PVP with Title V)
  - Foundation
  - Non-saleable registered class can be planted by the grower/licensee only to raise certified seed.
  - Certified

➤ **Soybean Conventional:**

- **ND1406HP**(PVP with Title V), ND Benson, ND Stutsman (PVP with Title V pending)
  - Foundation
  - Registered\*
  - Certified

\*Registered class can be planted by the grower/licensee or can be sold to members of DSS to raise certified class seed. Registered seed can be used to supply international licensees if need is recognized and approved by committee.

➤ **Soybean Glyphosate Tolerant**

- **ND17009GT Soybean** (PVP with Title V pending)
  - Foundation
  - Registered\*
  - Certified

\*Registered class can be planted by the grower/licensee or can be sold to members of DSS to raise certified class seed. Registered seed can be used to supply international licensees if need is recognized and approved by committee.

➤ **Flax**

- **Gold ND Flax** (PVP with no Title V)
  - Foundation
  - Registered\*
  - Certified

\*Registered class can be planted by the grower/licensee or can be sold to members of DSS to raise certified class seed. Registered seed can be used to supply international licensees if need is recognized and approved by committee.

➤ **Winter Rye**

- **ND Dylan** (PVP with Title V, Pending)
  - Foundation
  - Registered\*
  - Certified

\*Registered class can be planted by the grower/licensee or can be sold to members of DSS to raise certified class seed. Registered seed can be used to supply international licensees if need is recognized and approved by committee.

Winter Wheat \$ 0.60/bu sold as seed.

Winter Rye \$0.40/bu sold as seed.
